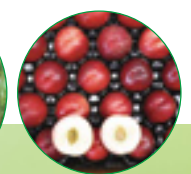
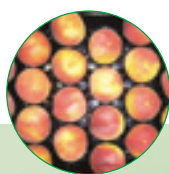
New Generation Rootstock Cornerstone For Almonds & Stonefruit

INFORMATION

- Resistant to root knot nematodes (*Meloidogyne Javanica* and *Meloidogyne Incognita*) species.
- It shows a low incidence of mortality due to phytophthora.
- Does not exhibit the degree of sensitivity to crown gall.

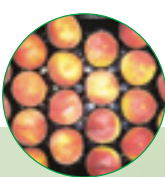
- Ideal rootstock for replant situations when existing orchards are removed.

- Tolerance to limestone soils.





Variety: *White Peach Snow Flame 25 on Cornerstone rootstock.*

INFORMATION

When peach and nectarine varieties are grafted on to 'Cornerstone' rootstock:

- The fruit produced exhibits larger fruit size.
- Tends to produce more lateral growth.
- It produces larger fruit wood.
- Fruit maturity on 'Cornerstone' can be delayed by 5-7 days approximately

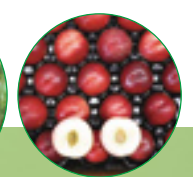
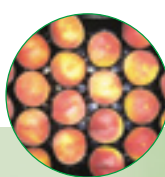
Variety: *White Nectarine Snow Flare 22 on Cornerstone rootstock. (Below)*
